## Reynaers help create eco-friendly Co-op

Reynaers systems are used throughout an impressive £4.5 million Co-operative Supermarket development in Oakham, Leicestershire. The aim of the project was to create a new 3,100m<sup>2</sup> store on a two hectare site just outside the town, replacing the original Midlands Co-op premises which was destroyed by fire in July 2008.

The new superstore is one of the most eco-friendly retail buildings in the country, featuring natural ventilation to the sales floor (as opposed to air conditioning) and using maximised natural light throughout the building.

## A BREEAM Rating of 'Very Good' and an Energy Performance Certificate grade 'A'

Reynaers CW50 curtain wall system allowed complete design freedom for KPW Architects, creating an aesthetically pleasing façade, that helps maximise natural light entry.

The structurally clamped curtain walling option (CW50 SC) was also used extensively throughout the new development, providing a seamless façade to the exterior of the building. Reynaers Eco Window system helped to ensure the building's thermal performance and achieved a BREEAM Rating of 'Very Good' and an Energy Performance Certificate grade 'A'.

## Sustainable Innovation in Coventry with Reynaers

Reynaers Aluminium has played a significant part in the creation of one of the most sustainable office buildings in Europe by providing curtain walling systems, windows and doors for the new Severn Trent headquarters, in Coventry. The products helped the building achieve an 'Excellent' BREEM rating.

### Three chamber window system helps ensure heat retention and thermal efficiency

The seven-storey, 38 metre-high building, built by BAM Construction, with the help of £6.5 million from Advantage West Midlands and support from Coventry City Council, has one of the lowest carbon footprints for any UK office building.

Reynaers CS68 window system was installed throughout the new development by Solaglas Contracting Midlands. The three chamber window system helps ensure heat retention and thermal efficiency. Also installed was Reynaers Vision 50, a robust high traffic door, ideal for ground floor entrances.

Webb Gray Architects specified a bespoke version of Reynaers CW50 curtain walling system to facilitate maximum creative freedom in their original design proposals. This in turn produced eye catching and appealing aesthetics and also provided maximum natural light exposure into the building.
