

Case Study: 198-202 Piccadilly



Reynaers' Windows And Doors Used In West End Development

Reynaers windows and doors have played a key role in a striking, prestigious development in the heart of London's West End. An eight storey commercial and retail development, 198-202 Piccadilly is a modern yet classical building which perfectly complements its distinguished surroundings.

Comprising 70,000 square feet of office space set above nearly 30,000 square feet of premier retail space, the development is the first to be built in the location for over 20 years and has been designed to express both the prestige of the area and the quality of its accommodation.

The sensitive nature of the site on one of London's best known thoroughfares meant that Reynaers systems had a vital role to play, as Paul Hanby Director of the architects for the project, Robert Adam Architects, explains: "The windows and doors had to be in harmony with the traditional feel of the building and its surroundings and the Reynaers CS68 Renaissance system does this perfectly. The classic 9mm deep fluting on the exterior and interior faces makes it aesthetically pleasing yet it also provides high insulation levels and optimal safety."
