

Case Study: St Mary Axe



Imposing location In The Heart Of The City

A range of Reynaers products were used at 50 St Mary Axe, an imposing development, prominently located in the heart of EC3. The site is located on the corner of Bevis Marks and St Mary Axe, formerly the site of the National Bank of Greece, and the building comprises a seven storey block with single basement.

Externally, architects, Black Architecture, have selected a limestone façade in response to the adjoining listed Baltic Exchange. Inside, the use of a single stair core and compact 'super-loos' at each level makes maximum use of the 4,400 square metres of floor space. The offices are fitted out to category 'A' giving the building a Very Good BREEAM rating.

Fabricators Faberdex installed, Reynaers CS68 doors, CS38 windows and CW50 curtain walling, all with an anodised bronze finish to complement the Portland stone.
